2014 has experienced a 23% increase in client appointments. We have provided care to more than 80 people per week. Approximately 135 volunteer hours are logged per month.

In addition to regular clientele, we help on average 15 people monthly, that walk into our office due to an immediate crisis.


VOLUNTEER FEEDBACK
